TENTATIVE BUDGET ADOPTED, HEARING SCHEDULED

At the August Board of Education meeting, Board members adopted the tentative 2015-2016 budget. The 2015-2016 budget is balanced and outlines projected revenue and expenditures for the coming year. The annual budget hearing will be held at the September 17th meeting of the Board of Education. The Board will consider budget adoption at that time.

Through comprehensive planning and diligent spending, School District 21 has continued to provide for students' instructional needs despite the financial challenges imposed by the State of Illinois on local school districts. Over the past year, expenditures have been reduced by \$2 million.
